



## **Part-time Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic**

Avery County, NC

Performs professional advanced life support work in operating an approved mobile medical unit, rescuing victims and performing advanced emergency care including the administration of life sustaining treatment to patients on-site and while in route to hospital. Serves as medic on call, directing care and response and overseeing work of assigned Basic or Intermediate EMT's. Inspects and tests response vehicles and their emergency equipment and supplies to ensure they are in proper working order.

### **Education/Experience requirements**

Graduation from high school and at least two years of experience in advanced emergency medical service work (EMT-P); or equivalent combination of training and experience. Certification by the NC Medical Examiners Board as an EMT-Paramedic and NC Driver's License. Other certifications such as BTLS, PALS, ACLD, EVD, NIMS, and HazMat may be required.
